- The king called for the first servant. He was angry. He thought the servant should have shown mercy on the other servant just as the king had shown him mercy.
- The king sent the first servant to the jailers.

- A parent asking their kid to finally clean their room.
- A group project at school but one person hasn't been doing any of the work.
