



GAME INSTRUCTIONS

Just the Facts

OVERVIEW

In this small group game, teams will compete to find answers to predetermined questions as fast as possible. The team that scores the most points by quickly answering the questions wins.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- A tablet, phone, or laptop for each team (If your students don't have this technology, consider assigning an adult volunteer/small group leader to each team to share their phone with the group.)
- Paper and pen or a whiteboard and dry erase markers for keeping track of the score
- 10-15 predetermined questions for students to look up, along with their corresponding answers. (See the "Prep" section for ideas.)
- All of your middle schoolers

HOW-TO

PREP

- Prep a list of 10-15 questions for students to look up, along with the corresponding answers. (Be careful not to ask questions that could lead to inappropriate web searches and results.)
Question Ideas: Historical sports scores, dates of inventions, answers to math problems, dates of strange news stories, and locations of odd landmarks
- Ensure there are enough devices for each group.
- Gather score keeping materials.

PLAY

1. Split students into small groups. (The size of the group may be determined by the number of devices you have, as each group can only use one device.)
2. The host will read off each question one-at-a-time and students will immediately use their device to try to find the answer as quickly as possible.
3. Once an answer is found, the first person to raise their hand and answer correctly wins their team a point. If an answer is blurted out without being called on, all other teams get a point.
4. Once all questions have been answered, the team with the most points wins. (Have a question ready in the event of a tie.)

LOW TECH OPTION

If no technology is available, you can still ask the questions and have all the teams attempt to answer. The closest answer to the question wins a point.

NOTE: This game is written to be played as a small group game but can adapted to an all-skate or stage game.
